The Archdiocese of Regina is seeking a compassionate and dedicated **Hospital Chaplain/Spiritual Care Provider** to minister to Roman Catholic patients, families, and hospital staff. This individual will offer spiritual support and sacramental care to those experiencing illness and crisis within urgent care facilities in Regina, primarily at Pasqua Hospital. The position is grounded in the healing mission of the Church and involves collaboration with priests, volunteers, hospital staff, and families. Ideally this is a full-time role with on-call time required. Three-quarter time or half time will be considered.

Specific Duties

- Visit and minister to Roman Catholic patients, offering spiritual companionship and prayer.
- Coordinate the provision of sacraments with local clergy.
- Provide support to staff and family members in need of pastoral care.
- Attend family meetings when requested by the family, physician, or social worker.
- Assist priests with hospital ministry and maintain an up-to-date on-call clergy list.
- Facilitate, support, and train volunteer pastoral care workers.
- Plan and assist with liturgical services and celebrations, as needed.
- Develop relationships with clergy for ongoing collaboration in spiritual care.

Qualifications

- Completion of at least one unit of Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE).
- Experience in spiritual care ministry within healthcare or similar settings.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Proven ability to work independently and collaboratively within interdisciplinary teams.
- Experience in organizing and training volunteers.
- Deep personal commitment to Jesus Christ and the ability to witness that faith in word and action.
- Willingness to participate in ongoing professional development in the field of pastoral care.

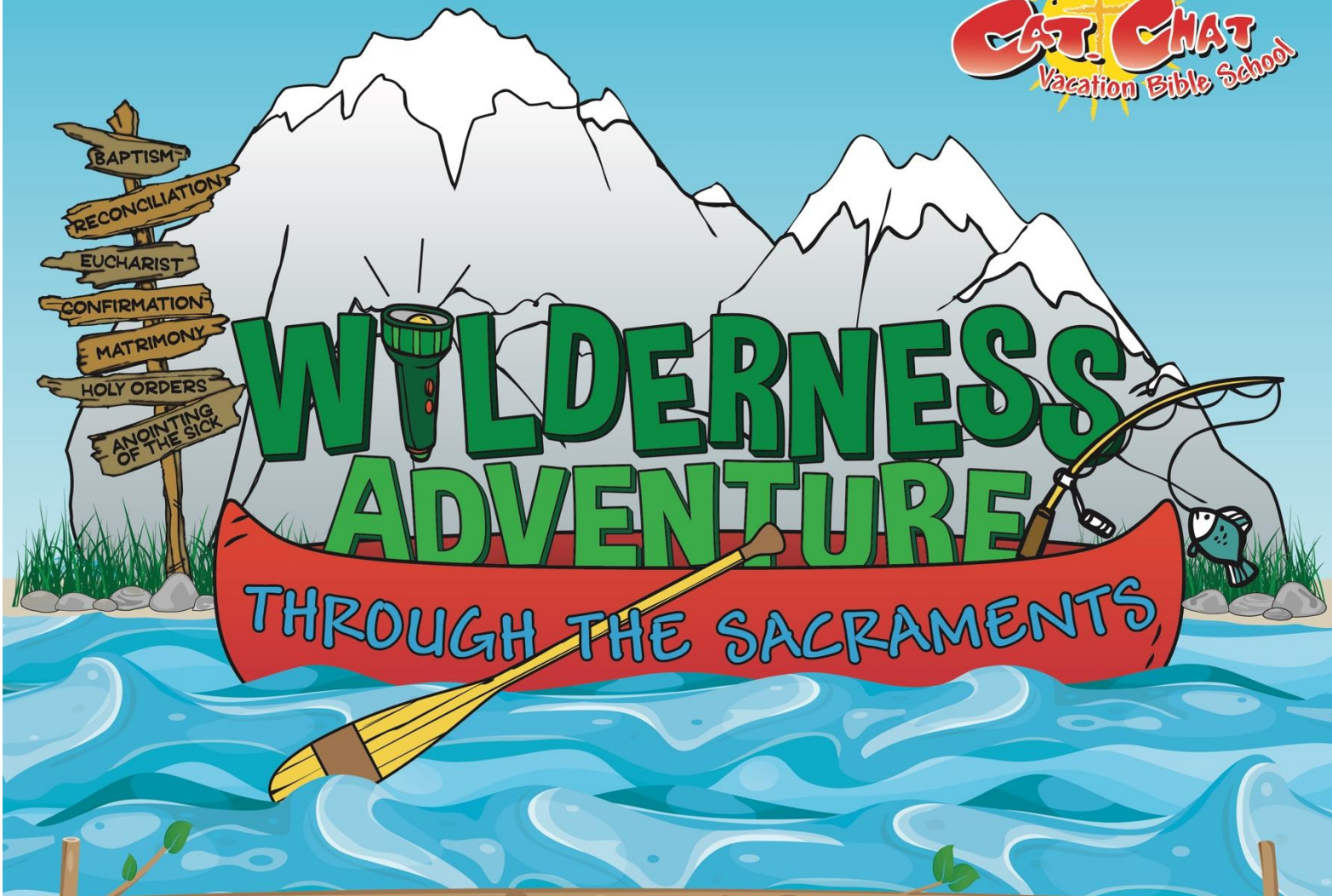
